

Al is a corporate officer of the Dineh Chamber of Commerce, taught business and economics courses at the University of New Mexico Gallup campus and Dine College. He has served as a member of the Navajo Council of Economic Advisors. AHEC is the business he formed in April 1982 to provide oil and gas wells services, waste management services and professional advisory services in business, economics and higher education. From 1997 to 2009 he held the position of Tribal Liaison at Northern Arizona University to work with tribes, tribal organizations and communities across Arizona and the southwest. In the 1980s he served as executive director of the Navajo Nation economic development division. Mr. Henderson was responsible for the completion of numerous Navajo Nation commercial shopping centers, establishment of the business and industrial development fund and the regional business development centers.

Mr. Henderson received his M.A. in economics from the University of New Mexico and B.A. from Eastern New Mexico University. In 2007 he received the Native American Community Scholars award from the Smithsonian Institution to conduct archival economics research in Washington, D.C.
